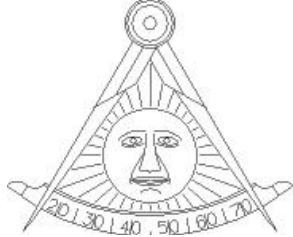

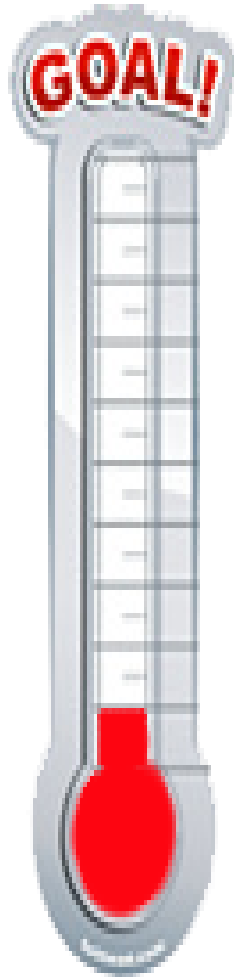

## From The East:

### **The Masons Are Coming**

Translated from: Masones Sin Fronteras  
Grand Lodge of Guatemala  
A conversation between Father & Son

F: Son, come look, the Masons are coming.

S: Who are they?

F: They are the ones who travel from East to West, and from North to South with their feet firmly placed in the universe.

S: Why does the ground shake every time they step?

F: Because they carry the weight of the Temple erected in Truth.

S: Where are they from?

F: They have no borders, the earth is their house, and the sky is their roof; they form a race with no colors, composed of all colors, but they have symbols that distinguish them from the rest of society.

S: How can you recognize them?

F: Because they carry with them the ability to speak without words, and they can point out the injustices, falsehoods, and hypocrisies of the world. To be among them, is the same as being at home. You do not need to wear a mask, it

is enough just to be yourself. But you must be true and faithful to your path.

S: How many types of Masons are there?

F: There are two, those that are Light and those still in their cocoons. Of the latter, there are many. Of the first, there are few. Of these few, their faces are firm, without wrinkles and folds. They fear nothing, because to be Light, you must first have died and then ascended. This is the only way to truly be alive. They were born from Earth's bosom in order to see the Light; then they became the Light, the same light that illuminates the path for their brothers. They are just like the butterflies that left their cocoons after having shed their old skin. They shed the skin composed of the superfluities of life, in order to display the beauty of holiness; The Beauty of Light, that light that comes only from within.
